



## **Golden Homes Canterbury Memorial Race Weekend 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> February 2022**

To meet the current requirements of the COVID-19 Protection Framework under a Red setting, NO SPECTATORS AND/OR PUBLIC WILL HAVE ACCESS TO PIT/LAUNCH AREAS at Rakaia Huts, Rakaia Gorge Bridge, Waimakariri SH1 Bridge and Waimakariri Gorge Bridge.

The Environment Canterbury Regional Council have issued Temporary Reservation Certificates on the Rakaia and Waimakariri Rivers as follows:

No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Areas as listed below except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, NZJBRRR Race Controller or the Harbourmaster.

- The Rakaia River from Rakaia Lagoon to Gorge Bridge from 00.01am until 23.59pm on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> February 2022.
- The Waimakariri River from State Highway One Motorway Bridge to Alpine Jet (Rubicon) from 00.01am until 23.59pm on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

### **Scheduled Race Times (note these could change at any time):**

#### **Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> February 2022 - Norm Bagrie Memorial Rakaia River Race**

Upstream - Rakaia Huts to Gorge Bridge - Start 11.00 am

Downstream - Gorge Bridge to Rakaia Huts - Start 1.30 pm

#### **Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2022 - Stuart Blanchard Memorial Waimakariri River Race**

Upstream - SH1 Bridge to Gorge Bridge - Start 10.00 am

Downstream - Gorge Bridge to SH1 Bridge - Start 1.00 pm

### **Reminder to Race Teams and Officials**

- Race Teams can only have a maximum of 4 people in the pit (launch) areas, this includes Driver and Navigator.
- Race Teams (4x per team) & Officials will be issued with wrist bands which MUST be worn to have access to the Pit/Launch Areas.
- All Race Team members and Officials must present their My Vaccine Pass at the check point on arrival each morning.
- All Race Team members and Officials must Check In with the NZCovid Tracer App in the Pits at the Bottom and Top of the river each day.
- Boats and Race Team members must stay inside the roped off pit areas during lunch and refueling etc as outlined in the information supplied to Racers earlier in the week.
